PA-A2 Eyebolt Installation Instructions

Description

The contents of the PA-A2 Eyebolt Kit allow you to rig one of the following loudspeakers/subwoofers:

DRM-212, DRM-215, DRM-315, DRM-18S, DRM-12A, DRM-212P, DRM-215P, DRM-315P, DRM-18SP, DRM-12AP, HD1801. HD1221. HDA.

Only ONE loudspeaker/subwoofer may be mounted per PA-A2 Eyebolt Kit.

Do not install the product in any way that is not described in these instructions.

WARNING: The eyebolt adapter kit has been tested to a Working Load Limit (WLL) of 545 kg / 1200 lb with a design factor of 5:1. The WLL derates to a 182 kg / 400 lb at a 45° pull. Do not use an eyebolt for an angled pull greater than 45°. At least two eyebolts should be used in any PA-A2 install. Never apply a load that exceeds the Working Load Limit.

Before suspending the loudspeaker/subwoofer, make all of the necessary calculations to ensure that all of the components are used within their nominal work load range. Remember that the weakest component determines the safety level of the entire installation.


Eyebolt Installation

Only one loudspeaker/subwoofer may be rigged per PA-A2 Eyebolt Kit. At least two eyebolts should be used in any installation utilizing the PA-A2 kit. Follow the steps below once you have found a suitable place to suspend the loudspeaker/subwoofer.

- 1. Using a 6 mm hex driver, remove the screws from the mounting points you wish to use.
- 2. Place the threaded part of the eyebolt through the washer.
- 3. Fully screw the eyebolt into the threaded insert of the loudspeaker/subwoofer.

VERY IMPORTANT: Do not over-tighten the eyebolt, as this could damage the threaded insert of the loudspeaker/subwoofer.

NOTE: A DRM loudspeaker is used in the example below. Please refer to the full manual on <u>mackie.com</u> for the location of the mounting points on your particular loudspeaker/subwoofer model.
